Importance of the Joulter Cays

- Protects important terrestrial habitats, coppice forest, mangrove stands & sandy shores.
- · Extensive rare oolite sand flats
- Nursery habitats for important marine species.
- · Andros Barrier Reef and coral reefs
- Deep water habitat for pelagic marine species & habitat for spawning bonefish, marine mammals and sea turtles.
- Important Bird Area: critical habitat for the endangered Piping Plover, Rufus Red Knot, Reddish Egrets and Short-billed Dowitchers.
- The Joulter Cays contribute \$141 million to the flats fishing industry in The Bahamas.
